### The Sin of Complacency

*Judges 6:1 The Israelites did evil in the eyes of the LORD, and for seven years he gave them into the hands of the Midianites.*

- **Main Point #1:** Be careful! It's easy to get spiritually complacent (and wander) when everything is going well.

*Judges 6:2 Because the power of Midian was so oppressive, the Israelites prepared shelters for themselves in mountain clefts, caves and strongholds.*

*Matthew 23:12 (NLT) ...those who exalt themselves will be humbled, and those who humble themselves will be exalted.*

*Judges 6:3-6 Whenever the Israelites planted their crops, the Midianites, Amalekites and other eastern peoples invaded the country. 4 They camped on the land and ruined the crops all the way to Gaza and did not spare a living thing for Israel, neither sheep nor cattle nor donkeys. 5 They came up with their livestock and their tents like swarms of locusts. It was impossible to count them or their camels; they invaded the land to ravage it. 6 Midian so impoverished the Israelites that they cried out to the LORD for help.*

- **Main Point #2:** Don't seek God out of desperation or as a last resort. Make seeking God your initial response!

*Judges 6:7-10 When the Israelites cried out to the LORD because of Midian, 8 he sent them a prophet, who said, "This is what the LORD, the God of Israel, says: I brought you up out of Egypt, out of the land of slavery. 9 I rescued you from the hand of the Egyptians. And I delivered you from the hand of all your oppressors; I drove them out before you and gave you their land. 10 I said to you, 'I am the LORD your God; do not worship the gods of the Amorites, in whose land you live.' But you have not listened to me."*

- **Main Point #3:** A Christ followers' lifestyle must match their words. Obeying God isn't optional, it's essential!

*Judges 6:11 The angel of the LORD came and sat down under the oak in Ophrah that belonged to Joash the Abiezerite, where his son Gideon was threshing wheat in a winepress to keep it from the Midianites.*

*John 1:18 No one has ever seen God, but the one and only Son, who is himself God and is in closest relationship with the Father, has made him known.*

*Judges 6:12* When the angel of the LORD appeared to Gideon, he said, "The LORD is with you, mighty warrior."

- **Main Point #4:** God sees you as His masterpiece. We only see the imperfect person in the mirror. See yourself like God does!

*Judges 6:13-23* "Pardon me, my lord," Gideon replied, "but if the LORD is with us, why has all this happened to us? Where are all his wonders that our ancestors told us about when they said, 'Did not the LORD bring us up out of Egypt?' But now the LORD has abandoned us and given us into the hand of Midian." **14** The LORD turned to him and said, "Go in the strength you have and save Israel out of Midian's hand. Am I not sending you?" **15** "Pardon me, my lord," Gideon replied, "but how can I save Israel? My clan is the weakest in Manasseh, and I am the least in my family." **16** The LORD answered, "I will be with you, and you will strike down all the Midianites, leaving none alive." **17** Gideon replied, "If now I have found favor in your eyes, give me a sign that it is really you talking to me. **18** Please do not go away until I come back and bring my offering and set it before you." And the LORD said, "I will wait until you return." **19** Gideon went inside, prepared a young goat, and from an ephah of flour he made bread without yeast. Putting the meat in a basket and its broth in a pot, he brought them out and offered them to him under the oak. **20** The angel of God said to him, "Take the meat and the unleavened bread, place them on this rock, and pour out the broth." And Gideon did so. **21** Then the angel of the LORD touched the meat and the unleavened bread with the tip of the staff that was in his hand. Fire flared from the rock, consuming the meat and the bread. And the angel of the LORD disappeared. **22** When Gideon realized that it was the angel of the LORD, he exclaimed, "Alas, Sovereign LORD! I have seen the angel of the LORD face to face!" **23** But the LORD said to him, "Peace! Do not be afraid. You are not going to die."

- **Main Point #5:** God KNOWS our fears. He may want us to cry out to Him, but He already KNOWS what we need.

*Judges 6:24-32* So Gideon built an altar to the LORD there and called it The LORD Is Peace. To this day it stands in Ophrah of the Abiezrites. **25** That same night the LORD said to him, "Take the second bull from your father's herd, the one seven years old. Tear down your father's altar to Baal and cut down the Asherah pole beside it. **26** Then build a proper kind of altar to the LORD your God on the top of this height. Using the wood of the Asherah pole that you cut down, offer the second bull as a burnt offering." **27** So Gideon took ten of his servants and did as the LORD told him. But because he was afraid of his family and the townspeople, he did it at night rather than in the daytime. **28** In the morning when the people of the town got up, there was Baal's altar, demolished, with the Asherah pole beside it cut down and the second bull sacrificed on the newly built altar! **29** They asked each other, "Who did this?" When they carefully investigated, they were told, "Gideon son of Joash did it." **30** The people of the town demanded of Joash, "Bring out your son. He must die, because he has broken down Baal's altar and cut down the Asherah pole beside it." **31** But Joash replied to the hostile crowd around him, "Are you going to plead Baal's cause? Are you trying to save him? Whoever fights for him shall be put to death by morning! If Baal really is a god, he can defend himself when someone breaks down his altar." **32** So because Gideon broke down Baal's altar, they gave him the name Jerub-Baal that day, saying, "Let Baal contend with

him.”

*John 16:33* “I have told you these things, so that in me you may have peace. In this world you will have trouble. But take heart! I have overcome the world.”

- **Main Point #6:** Satan may contend with us, but he can’t overcome us. Our God is stronger!
