Psalm 1:1-6 <u>Blessed</u> is the one who does not walk in step with the wicked or stand in the way that sinners take or sit in the company of mockers, 2 but whose <u>delight is in the law of the LORD</u>, and who <u>meditates</u> on his <u>law day and night</u>. 3 That person is like a tree planted by streams of water, which <u>yields its fruit</u> in season and whose leaf <u>does not wither</u>--whatever they do <u>prospers</u>. 4 Not so the wicked! They are like chaff that the wind blows away. 5 Therefore the wicked will not stand in the judgment, nor sinners in the assembly of the righteous. 6 For <u>the LORD watches over</u> the way of the righteous, but the way of the wicked leads to destruction.

- A personal devotional time is prayerful focus on Scripture, what it reveals about God's Character and truths, and how it applies to our lives
- A consistent personal devotional time opens the door to blessing, fruitfulness, strength, relationship, discernment and transformation

Mark 1:35 (ESV) And rising very early in the morning, while it was still dark, he departed and went out to a desolate place, and there he prayed.

• Peter and John

Acts 4:13 When they saw the courage of Peter and John and realized that they were unschooled, ordinary men, they were astonished and they took note that these men had been with Jesus.

Lamentations 3:25-26, 28 (ESV) The LORD is good to those who wait for him, to the soul who seeks him. 26 It is good that one should <u>wait quietly</u> for the salvation of the LORD. ... 28 Let him <u>sit</u> alone in silence when it is laid on him:

Matthew 6:6 But when you pray, go into your room, close the door and pray to your Father, who is unseen. Then your Father, who sees <u>what is done in secret</u>, will reward you.
